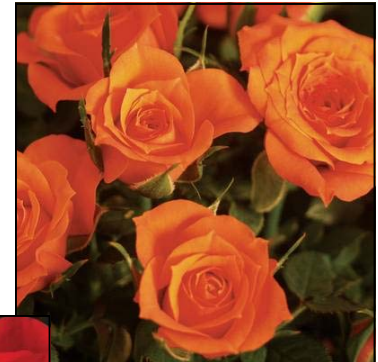

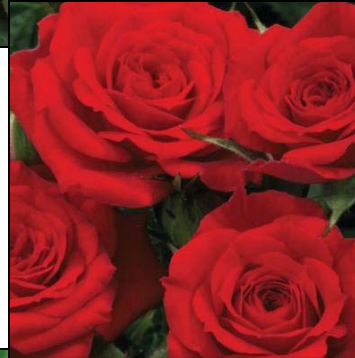

Phyllostachys nigra 'Henon'

Phyllostachys nigra 'Henon' is native to many different areas of China and thought to be the actual "true" nigra species. Tall upright habit with delicate foliage lends an impressive display in the garden. Strong canes mature to a grayish olive color. This variety expresses good vigor. It will grow taller and proves to be hardier than Phyllostachys nigra. It is reputedly drought tolerant once established. In cold zones, such as 5b, it likely will only achieve a maximum height of approximately 15-25'. In more temperate climates such as the West Coast, it can reach heights of up to 60'.



Hardenbergia 'Meema'

In the garden Meema is a shrubby ground cover that gets 1 1/2 - 2 ft high, with a 2 ft. spread, but it will creep up things if allowed to. In a pot it has the ability to grow in a clump, holding great form without the need for a trellis, making an easy retail plant to grow. Water as required to keep the plant healthy for the first 8 to 16 weeks. Once established, irrigation may only be necessary during extreme drought.
