## The Ground cover Westringia



At last, a tough beautiful ground cover Westringia. Westringias are one of the most popular shrubs, due to their toughness, and all year round clean foliage. Now Mundi will give people the same benefits but in a ground cover form. Mundi grows to about 400mm high with a spread of 1.5 metres. As you can see in the picture, this unpruned mature plant does not even reach knee height.



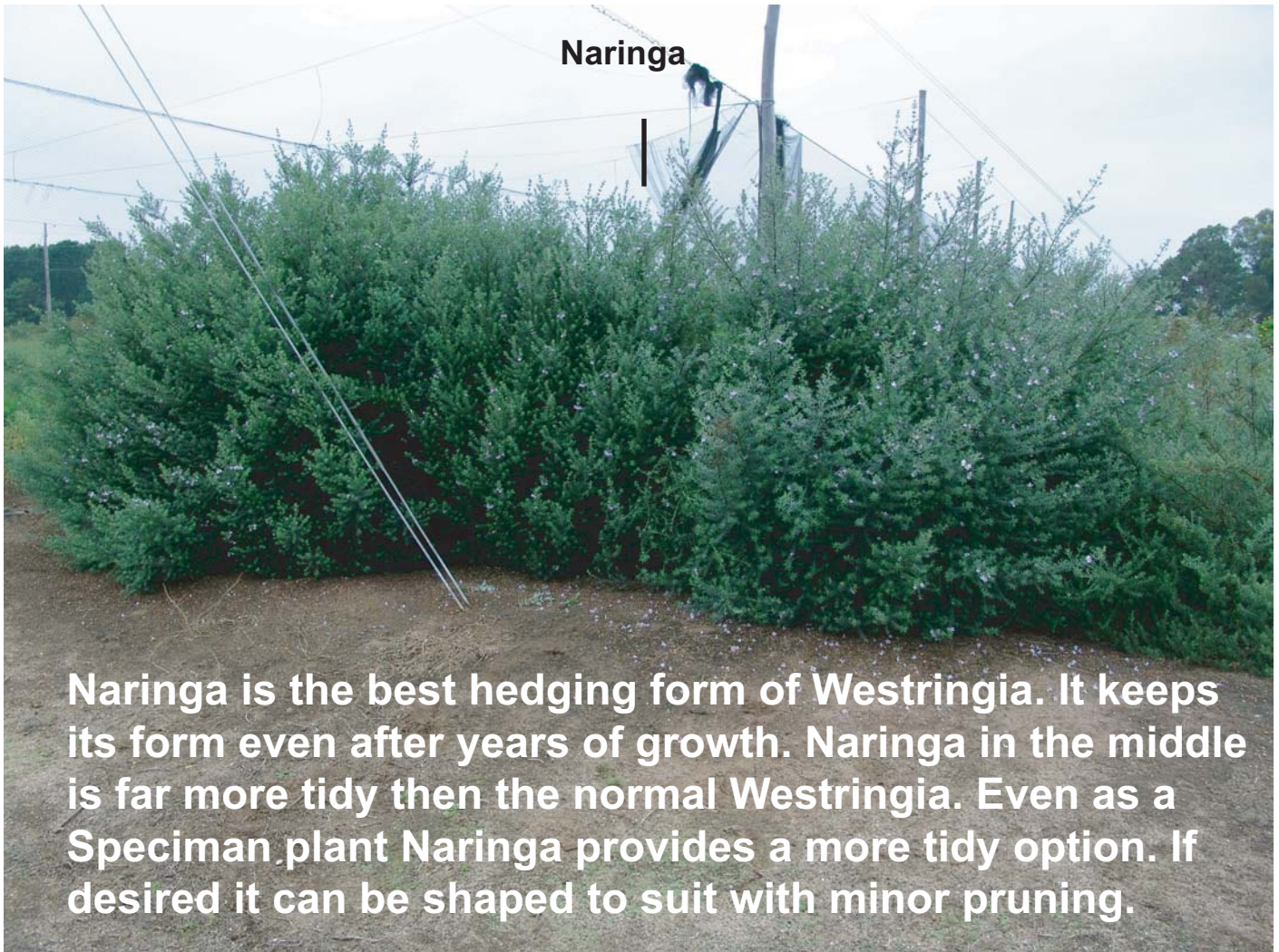
Mundi is an ideal plant for tough road-sides, for mass planting as a ground cover in gardens and large amenity areas. Great for where you need a low growing plant that gets minimal care. Mundi is tough enough to live on natural rainfall in most areas of the East Coast of Australia. Mundi has good sized white flowers in Spring.





# Naringa<sup>TM</sup>

Westringia 'WES01'



Westringia is known to be one of the tough Australian Native shrubs. It is widely used, and performs well in the landscape. However to keep it at its best it needs pruning every one to two years. Naringa needs pruning at least half as much as other Westringias, and in a natural setting probably not at all. Naringa gives you a tidy look with out the work. It flowers profusely in Spring, and regularly at other times. Naringa grows to 2 metres high (1 metre with pruning) with a 500mm to 800mm spread.
