Colocasia 'Puckered Up'

This beauty has deeply puckered, dark chocolate leaves that are supported by strong, near-black stems on a bushy yet compact plant. 'Puckered Up' is good for container plants, gardens and borders.

Zone 8-11
Available as 72cp

Availability starting early Fall 2013



Lycium barbarum (Goji Berry)

Goji plants are deciduous and very adaptable, growing to 4' to 7' tall with arching branches. For best results, soil should be between 6.8-8.1. These require a well-drained media and full to partial sun. Goji can be easily grown in containers for a deck or patio plant or in the field. The plants are drought tolerant once established. In mid summer the 1" long orange-red fruits ripen, and can be dried or eaten fresh. The edible leaves can be picked to use fresh in salads or dried in a dehydrator, then crushed into a powder.

Perennial in zones 3 to 10
Available as 72cp

Availability starting late July/early August
