## Featured Plants-Other Hydrangeas Types



### Snow Queen

A quercifolia variety, this Oak Leaf holds its blooms upright. It is pure white cones of flower panicales that fade to Pink. The leathery leaves turn to burgundy in the Fall.

Available as 21cp and 50cp



### Harlequin

A macrophylla variety, Harlequin is a bicolor Hydrangea with mophead blooms of pinkish-red and white. The sturdy stems have an extremely vigorous growth habit and is better in milder climates. Late flowers could produced single colors. Fall.

Available as 21cp and 50cp



### Enziandom

A macrophylla variety, Enziandom is the darkest of the Blues. It is deep gentian-blue mophead. It blooms from mid to late summer through Fall. It also resists schorching in the hot sun.
